

Commercial Use of Public Property

Emergency Ordinance assisting businesses to comply with reopening restaurant guidelines due to COVID-19.

What do I need to turn in to the City before using public property for my business?

- Certificate general liability insurance with the City listed as an additional insured.
 - Minimum coverage amounts: \$50,000 per occurrence, \$10,000 per occurrence for property damage, and \$300,000 aggregate for personal injury or death
- Businesses selling alcohol must complete an additional agreement & submit a map of the location of sales

Who should I turn my certificate of insurance and/or agreements into?

• The City Clerk's office (320-235-4913)

What regulations do I need to follow when using public property for my business?

- Public Property may include sidewalk space, on-street parking spaces, green space, etc.
- Areas used must be directly abutting the brick & mortar location of the business
- 5 foot sidewalk path & 12 foot drive lane must remain open for passing pedestrian & vehicle traffic
- Bright, visible barricades should be used around the perimeters of the parking spaces used



- Tables, chairs, etc shall be not fixed to the sidewalk/roadway
- Area must remain litter free at all times
- Temporary outdoor signage is allowed -- no additional permits are needed
- All state reopening & social distancing guidelines shall be complied with -- visit https://mn.gov/covid19/for-minnesotans/stay-safe-mn/stay-safe-plan.jsp for more information.
